## From the Violet People to the World Government

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It seems that it was Mr. Soros, the Finance guru, who assigned the Violet color to the "Internet People". From the very beginning, the 'sacrality' of Europe has been imposed over the people with such a strength that the main italian newspaper put the european flag on its first page, long time before the euro was created. It is a very meaningful fact that no italian newspaper has the italian flag on its first page, and the Corriere della Sera has just the european one. But recently this flag was sometimes covered by very profane images, such as soccer players, singers... even by Maria de Filippi (an italian TV star). At the same time the Corriere della Sera published very critical essays about the "foolish expenses" of the European parliament, about the cracks of the Euro, and even about the possibility that Greece guits the European Union. The Corriere della Sera is now focusing on its target at same time that the high Finance chose to start its springtime campaign: the Violet People and the World Government.

Just a few unavoidable questions. Has the economic and monetary crisis been planned in advance? Is the Euro supposed to die, leaving an empty space for a unique world coinage? It is difficult to answer these questions being outside of the invisible command posts.
