## Why Italy Must Say NO to War in Libya

It is true: there is no evidence, there are no documents: but logic is telling us that Islam il launching its final assault to us. But now the first and only duty of our governors is to protect their people and their goods. This means to protect the integrity of the territory, the culture, the identity, all what a people owns. This is not a "clash of civilizations", as it was often said. With immigration their are using a cunning strategy: no need to fight, they will just win over us taking advantage of the values we are so proud. They will defeat us without war, just with their presence. This is why Italy must not consent to acts of war - no matter who will decide them - because the result would be a series of destructive war actions in Italy, together with disorders and massacres in the african countries for a long time to come. No economical interest can justify such a scenario. And an act of war would not save us from immigration, which is the real and final goal of all what is happening right now.

The Italian government must immediately give a clear signal that nobody will be allowed to cross our national borders; no boat must be allowed to enter the national sea waters. The Schengen treaty must be suspended without being afraid of negative reactions from Europe. Italy is in a strong position: what would be Europe without Italy? Where would be Europe's borders? How credible would be the very idea of an United Europe if Italy is not part of it? Italy with the ancient Romans created the history and the essence of Europe; the Romans founded London, Paris, York, Strasbourg. They created the languages and the laws, they propagated religion and the Pope lives in Italy. We have the right and the duty to save this all.
