

Italy in the Hands of Bilderberg & C.

We are grabbed by the throat, immobilized, we are paralyzed, when we see so many people committing suicide every day; because we are in the hands of Bankers who not only are bankers but also members of the Trilateral Commission, of the Bilderberg Club, of the Aspen Institute, of the Masonic organizations that hold in their hands the European power at its highest levels. They do not work for us, they work to create the World Government. Italy is in their power, because the highest representatives of the parties of the Left always belonged to one of these associations. In his valuable "corner" of the Italian newspaper "Il Giornale", Paolo Granzotto is listing the names of future possible candidates to the Italian Presidency: Giuliano Amato, Romano Prodi, Mario Monti. This is why it would be advisable to support the proposal of the PdL party [of Berlusconi] to have the President of Italy directly elected by the citizens. This would be the only way to escape our eternal destiny of having a President chosen by those associations. However, it would be necessary to leave untouched the constitutional form of the power of the President, since otherwise the whole Italian political system should have to be changed, and it is not possible to do it in a short time. Together with the proposal of the direct election of the President of the Italian Republic, a plan it should be presented to deal in the most practical and effective way with the extremely urgent problems of our economic survival.

No party today can afford to ignore the reality of bankruptcy in which we are living virtually "day by day", watching the stock market or the spread, waiting for the elections in Greece or for the failure of the Spanish banks. Our 'emergency government' simply transformed 'emergency' in a long, mournful state of 'normality': every day they invent a new tax, driving the citizens to despair. So many people are committing suicide, and we must say clearly that those suicides are caused by the will of destroying the Italian nation (or inability to govern it). The politicians who are still in office must now wake up from their lethargic passivity.

Our problem is the currency? Well the PDL and the other parties must clearly say what they want to do about it. This is what mr. Grillo was talking about, and this is why he created his Movimento Cinque Stelle through the web. It's been several years that people passionately discuss on the Web about the problems of monetary sovereignty, and about the fact that politicians have handed up to to the bankers the right to issue currency. With just a click, it is possible to find the names of all the associations who are working to attain the World Government, and the names of their members, including the italian ones. On the web, it is possible to find hundreds of simulations and hypotheses that were made by major economists about the future of the euro; and we can read about the pros and cons of remaining within the single currency.

No one, especially politicians, can now keep silent about the two possibilities that are in front of us, both at the State and at the World level. If they do not want to die, they must come out and decide once for all in which direction they want to go.
