Greece surrenders to the European Dictatorship

Greece! Despite all what happened in the last years of crisis, it seems impossible that Greece will permanently delete herself as an independent State and as a beacon of civilization. The very same Greece that Europe never forgot during the long centuries of its history, with Homer and the Parthenon, the Olympic games and Ulysses. Santorre Santarosa and George Byron fought and died for the freedom of Greece. Today Greece is totally renouncing her own identity and is surrendering to the European dictatorship. The Parliament is in fact approving a rule that - in brief - will punish with imprisonment for at least six months anyone who does not obey the decisions of the "EU Regulations". Therefore, Greek governors have come to this point of submission? Although we feel a deep sorrow, we should not be amazed because this final brutalization is unavoidable. It happens because in the last years greek politicians decided to sell (and sell off) the properties of the People, forgetting that they are not the owners but the temporary administrators of those goods. Because they accepted the economic management of the socalled Troika, people sent by the FMI and the Central European Bank, who forced greek people to live in the most miserable conditions in order to remain within the euro.

In front of this legislation, however, we have an obligation to set aside the reflections about the slavery of Greece, in order to highlight the fullblown totalitarianism of the European empire. Although it is the Greek parliament that approved this standard, it was a direct expression of the European authority; and no one should delude thinking that this is applying only to Greece. These rules are virtually indispensable for the construction that has been built over the heads of the People and that cannot hold on for a longer time without Dictatorship. This is in fact the situation in which you will soon find the much celebrated European Union, with its 28 or more member States that must be kept under its rule, and the hundreds of millions of people to whom they are imposing their will, their ideology and their own power. The thinking minds hidden

behind the virtually faceless "authorities " (Troika, Oms, European Central Bank and UN) are already in command; they are prepared to possible future rebellions, and therefore they are creating a legal cage by which the freedom of the persons and of the institutions will be trampled. Greece did not rebel: it is good sign for them, but it is also the last chance for us, and for our leaders, to save us from the same fate. Today these rules have a 'political' face, but all coercive rules coming from Europe - even when they do not seem to be 'political' - are aimed at the same goal: to homogenize the People who will be governed by a single commanding center, reducing them to single individuals who are all alike, because they are deprived of all good things that differentiate them (they will have no sex, no relatives, no home). All these rules provide the same kind of punishment for those who do not obey: imprisonment. An example is the law against homophobia: nobody was amazed, although it is a law concerning a crime of opinion. The idea that "Europe" and "imprisonment " are a whole has already been introjected; or rather everyone knows that the European empire can be kept together only with Dictatorship and imprisonment.
